9/11 COMMISSION TO ASSESS PROGRESS ON RECOMMENDATIONS

Thomas H. Kean, former chair of the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States (9/11 Commission), and Lee H. Hamilton, the commission's former vice chair, announced today that they and their former colleagues on the 9/11 Commission will convene a series of public panels to assess the U.S. government's progress in implementing the recommendations of the *9/11 Commission Report*. The series, which will culminate in a "report card" on implementation of the Commission's recommendations, will be entitled *The 9/11 Commission Recommendations: The Unfinished Agenda*.

The first public panel, on CIA and FBI Reform, will be moderated by 9/11 Commissioner, and former Deputy Attorney General of the United States, Jamie S. Gorelick. The panel will feature Richard Thornburgh; former Attorney General of the United States; John Gannon, former Chairman of the National Intelligence Council; and Chitra Ragavan, staff writer for US News and World Report.
