John F. Lehman, a member of the board of the 9/11 Public Discourse Project, is a former member of the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States (9/11 Commission). Lehman was appointed Secretary of the Navy by President Reagan in 1981, serving until 1987. During his tenure he was responsible for building the 600-ship Navy and establishing a strategy of maritime supremacy for the United States. He is currently chairman of J.F. Lehman & Company, a private equity investment firm.

The Hon. Jane Harman

Congresswoman Jane Harman represents California's 36<sup>th</sup> Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives. She was appointed as Ranking Minority Member of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence for the 108<sup>th</sup> and 109<sup>th</sup> Congresses, and serves on the House Committee on Homeland Security. Working in a bipartisan fashion with HPSCI Chairman Rep. Peter Hoekstra, she played a central role in the passage of the historic Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004.

Admiral William O. Studeman

Admiral Studeman recently served as a member of the President's Commission on the Intelligence Capabilities of the United States Regarding Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD Commission). He formerly served as Deputy Director of Central Intelligence under DCI's Robert Gates, James Woolsey, and John Deutch, including two extensive periods of service as Acting Director of Central Intelligence. Admiral Studeman is currently a member of the Defense Science Board and the Council on Foreign Relations.

Siobhan Gorman

Siobhan Gorman is a staff correspondent for *National Journal*, where she has covered a wide range of policy issues since April 1998. Since 9/11 she has written extensively on intelligence and homeland security topics. Recently she has closely covered intelligence reform and early developments in the Office of the Director of National Intelligence. After seven years with *National Journal*, she will soon be moving to cover national security issues for the *Baltimore Sun*.
