# THE 9/11 COMMISSION REPORT: THE UNFINISHED AGENDA

## Lee H. Hamilton, Moderator



Lee H. Hamilton, Vice Chair of the board of the 9/11 Public Discourse Project, served as Vice Chair of the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States (9/11 Commission). Hamilton is currently president and director of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars. Prior to becoming director of the Woodrow Wilson Center in 1999, he served for 34 years in Congress representing Indiana's Ninth District. During his tenure in the House, he served as chairman and ranking member of the House Committee on Foreign Affairs (now the Committee on International Relations), chairing the Subcommittee on Europe and the Middle East from the early 1970s until 1993.

## Ambassador A. Elizabeth Jones

A. Elizabeth Jones was sworn in as Assistant Secretary for European and Eurasian Affairs on May 31, 2001. Previously, she served as Senior Advisor for Caspian Basin Energy Diplomacy after having been Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary in the State Department's Bureau of Near Eastern Affairs. From 1995 to 1998, Ms. Jones was Ambassador to the Republic of Kazakhstan and Executive Assistant to Secretary of State Warren Christopher from 1993 to 1994. Her other Washington assignments include Deputy Director for Lebanon, Jordan, Syria, and Iraq, Lebanon Desk Officer, and public affairs officer in the Near East and South Asia Bureau.

## Ambassador Dennis Ross

Ambassador Ross was U.S. point man on the Arab-Israeli peace process in both the George H. W. Bush and Bill Clinton administrations. He assisted Israelis and Palestinians to reach the 1995 Interim Agreement; he also brokered the 1997 Hebron Accord, and facilitated the 1994 Israel-Jordan peace treaty. Prior to his service as special Middle East coordinator under President Clinton, Ambassador Ross served as director of the State Department's Policy Planning Staff in the first Bush administration, playing a prominent role in U.S. policy toward the former Soviet Union, the reunification of Germany and its integration into NATO, arms control negotiations, and the 1991 Gulf War coalition.
